RECare Information

- Winter moratorium is from Nov. 1-Apr. 1. If you struggle to pay your electric bill, consider contacting your community action agency for help. Eligibility for those 60 and over and the disabled begins on Oct. 1, and eligibility for everyone else begins on Nov. 1.
- Member-funded RECare provides local community action agencies with resources to help low-income members pay for winter heating bills. Each co-op family may receive up to \$200 per year for heating assistance. Families with all-electric home heating may receive up to \$400 per year.
- To qualify for assistance co-op members must apply at their local community action agency for the Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP). Even if a family's income may be over the maximum, the co-op member still must apply for LIHEAP. We cannot give RECare funds without the approval of a community action agency.
- Last year our members helped 10 households for an average of \$211 per household.
